The First Baptist Church at 10790 Hunts Corners Road is set on a non-standard lot, located on the north side of the street between Salt Road and Utley Road. Hunts Corner Road is a residential east-west corridor in the eastern section of the Town of Clarence. This traditionally arranged and proportioned, brick, front gabled chapel with modest Romanesque styling is eight bays deep by approximately four bays wide. A large square steeple is to the west, and stained glass windows are located in the east and west elevations.

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The Hunts Corner Cemetery at 10790 Hunts Corners Road is set on a non-standard lot, located on the north side of the street between Salt Road and Utley Road. Hunts Corner Road is a residential east-west corridor in the eastern section of the Town of Clarence. The cemetery was established circa 1860 and is associated to the First Baptist Church.

**Narrative Description of Significance:** Briefly describe those characteristics by which this property may be considered historically significant. Significance may include, but is not limited to, a structure being an intact representative of an architectural or engineering type or style (e.g., Gothic Revival style cottage, Pratt through-truss bridge); association with historic events or broad patterns of local, state or national history (e.g.: a cotton mill from a period of growth in local history, a seaside cottage representing a locale's history as a resort community, a structure associated with activities of the "underground railroad."); or by association with persons or organizations significant at a local, state or national level. The Hunts Corner Cemetery at 10790 Hunts Corners Road is significant as a mid nineteenth century cemetery associated with First Baptist Church, over 450 burials. The cemetery is cared for by the Town of Clarence. Managed by the Hunts Corners Cemetery Association. Stated to be established in 1860, however, many earlier burial dates recorded on headstones.
